

The Board of Directors is comprised of equal representation (as nearly as possible) of corporations and labor organizations. All policy positions require a three-fourths vote of the directors present and voting on an issue. The Board meets twice a year: in the spring and again in late November.

The founding members were Douglas A. Fraser (1916-2008), president emeritus International Union, UAW, and James M. Roche (1906-2004), former chair and CEO General Motors. The first co-chairs were Irving J. Bluestone (1917-2007), former vice president International Union, UAW, and Fred G. Secret (1922-2016), former executive vice president Ford Motor Company.
